**Bariatric Care Center** - The Bariatric Care Center at Summa Health System offers a wide-ranging approach to weight reduction. Summa's complete program has both medical (non-surgical) and minimally invasive surgical components. Highly skilled, experienced teams utilize the latest technology in order to help patients meet their weight loss goals, and care plans are customized to meet the individual healthcare needs of patients. The Bariatric Care Center program is in compliance with, and modeled after, the standards of the American Society for Bariatric Surgery (ASBS) and Surgical Review Corporation (SRC). Summa's Bariatric Care Center has been an American Society of Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery (ASMBS) Center of Excellence since 2007.

**Behavioral Health** - The Summa Center for Behavioral Health is committed to offering the care and support to help people survive, adapt and gather new hope and possibilities in their lives. The center offers a wide range of psychiatric and medical treatment services and provides a full continuum of care for patients with behavioral health needs. From inpatient services to specialized and individual outpatient services, like the Ignatia Hall Intensive Outpatient Program, the Summa Center for Behavioral Health is designed to help individuals suffering from alcohol or chemical dependencies.

**Cancer Care** - Summa Health System holds one of the highest ratings by the American College of Surgeons Commission on Cancer and offers comprehensive cancer care services at the Jean and Milton Cooper Cancer Center on the Summa Akron City Hospital campus and the Parkview Center at Summa Barberton Hospital. Both outpatient centers offer the latest in cancer treatment options to meet each patient's unique needs in a convenient, homelike setting.

**Cardiovascular** - Summa Health System provides testing and treatment for cardiovascular issues affecting the heart, lungs and circulatory system. From prevention to detection, treatment to long-term care, Summa offers state-of-the-art treatment and technology with exceptional patient outcomes that gain national recognition.

**Emergency Services** - The Trauma Center at Summa Health System offers multiple disciplines and specialties, all with the goal of ensuring the best patient care. Highly skilled emergency department teams, including emergency physicians, enable Summa to provide all the appropriate expertise and resources necessary for the highest quality care available. Summa Akron City Hospital has been verified as a Level I trauma center since 1998 and Summa affiliate Robinson Memorial Hospital has been verified as a Level 3 trauma center since 2003.

**Orthopaedics** - Ranked one of the Top 50 hospitals for orthopaedic care by U.S. News & World Report, Summa Health System is renowned for innovation and excellence in orthopaedics. In 2009, the Crystal Clinic Orthopaedic Center, a partnership between Summa Health System and Crystal Clinic, began operations, bringing together the talent and resources of two nationally-recognized orthopaedics programs specializing in the evaluation and treatment of conditions affecting the musculoskeletal system.

**Post Acute and Senior Services** - Summa Health System offers a comprehensive list of programs and services focused on the unique medical issues of older adults. Summa offers comprehensive assessments for older adults with chronic illness and/or functional difficulties at the Center for Senior Health, specialized inpatient and outpatient care including the Acute Care for Elders (ACE) Unit, geriatric psychiatry, SummaCare Physician House Calls program, urogynecology and neuropsychology services. Summa's Post Acute and Senior Services has received numerous grants from the National Institutes of Health and the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality.

**Sports Health** - Sports medicine specialists employ a team approach to sports medicine services, ensuring that athletes are involved in every stage of their care and treatment, from sports health education to injury prevention to diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation.

**Surgical Services** - Summa is moving toward more minimally invasive surgical techniques, adding new cutting-edge technology and programs, including robotic-assisted surgery, a Telemedical Center, bariatric surgery and bloodless surgery. Summa's board-certified surgeons perform more than 24,000 surgeries a year on both an inpatient and outpatient basis at Summa Akron City Hospital, Summa St. Thomas Hospital, Summa Western Reserve Hospital and Specialty Surgery Center locations.

**Women's Health** - From the preventive care of mammography to mature care through bone density services, Summa Health System provides innovative, patient-centered care for women. Summa's unique programs include the Pelvic Pain Specialty Center, Urogynecological/Incontinence Care and the Institute for Minimally Invasive Therapeutics.
